

Guidelines for requesting funding

In alignment with Dicerna's commitment to scientific innovation and areas of unmet medical needs, Dicerna supports educational grants and charitable donations in the following areas:

- Primary Hyperoxaluria
- Alpha-1 Antitrypsin Deficiency

Types of funding that may be awarded

Dicerna will review funding requests from healthcare or science related organizations for the following types of requests:

- Continuing Medical Education (CME) Grants
- Educational Grants
- Clinical Research Grants
- Investigator Initiated Trials (IIT) Grants
- Patient Organization Grants
- Charitable Donations

How do we define Grants and Charitable Donations?

Grants

- Grants funding may be provided to support a medical education program and events related to disease states, patient care, scientific and medical information of interest.
- Educational grants can be for the benefit of HCPs, patients or caregivers. These grants are intended to be non-promotional in nature.

Charitable Donations

- Charitable donations are to support initiatives and organizations that are aligned with our focus on improving patient health in specific therapeutic areas.
 - Primary Hyperoxaluria
 - Alpha-1 Antitrypsin Deficiency
- Charitable donations are not provided in place of a price discount, in exchange for a tangible benefit or associated with commercial activity. These donations are made without an exchange of value to Dicerna.

Who should complete the funding request form?

Healthcare Institution

If you are writing on behalf of a healthcare institution looking for CME or other educational activities such as grand rounds.

Professional Society

If you are representing a professional society applying for a relevant medical, scientific or educational event.

Patient Organization

If you are requesting support for healthcare related events or educational activities for patients.

Not-for-Profit Organization

If you represent an independent 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that provides disease-based education and patient/caregiver support. Donations may be provided in monetary support or in-kind donations.


Clinical Researcher or Investigator

If you are a researcher or a clinical investigator interested in funded research and trials.

Criteria used to review funding requests

When Dicerna reviews funding requests, it considers the following:

- Increases scientific understanding related to Dicerna's areas of medical and scientific interest
- Supports excellence in patient care
- Meets ACCME or CME guidelines, as applicable
- Educates at an appropriate venue conducive to an effective and efficient learning environment, at reasonable cost
- Budgetary considerations
- Is permissible under applicable laws, regulations, guidance and industry codes



Outside the scope of this program

- Educational grants or charitable donations to individuals or healthcare group practices
- Capital campaigns/building funds
- Service contracts
- Religious programs
- Political programs
- Entertainment (e.g., class reunions, retirement dinners)
- General capital or operating expenses (e.g., office equipment/staff, hardware/software, etc.)
- Textbooks and journal subscriptions
- Mass media productions not associated with education content (e.g., CD-ROMS, webcasts, journal supplements)
- Personal development (e.g., leadership training)

Future events only

We provide funding for future events only. Any request for an event that has occurred in the past will be automatically rejected.

No excluded or sanctioned entities

We only consider funding requests from organizations that are not listed on the Office of Inspector General's List of Excluded Individuals and Entities (OIG LEIE) or the General Services Administration Excluded Parties List System (GSA EPLS) or equivalent, dependent on your country.

Process for submitting funding requests

Please complete Dicerna's Medical Education and Grant Request Form providing all necessary information and documentation.

Funding request response

Timely Decisions

Dicerna intends to inform you of a funding determination within 30 days after the receipt of all required documentation. You can help minimize the review timeline by providing complete and accurate documentation.

Incomplete requests for funding will be removed from consideration after 60 days of initial submission.

Notification of Determination

Every funding request will receive a notification of decision, whether approval or rejection. We respect your time and effort in your application.
